Itinerary:

Day 1: London – Windsor Castle – Roman Bath – London

Report at 1 designated place in London. Pickup and proceed to Windsor Castle. Entrance to Windsor Castle.

Windsor Castle is the oldest and largest occupied castle in the world. It is open to visitors throughout the year. Founded by William the Conqueror in the 11th century, it has since been the home of 40 monarchs.

Later proceed to Bath.

The Roman Baths are well-preserved thermae in the city of Bath, Somerset, England. A temple was constructed on the site between 60–70AD in the first few decades of Roman Britain. Its presence led to the development of the small Roman urban settlement known as Aquae Sulis around the site. The Roman baths—designed for public bathing—were used until the end of Roman rule in Britain in the 5th century AD. According to the Anglo-Saxon Chronicle, the original Roman baths were in ruins a century later. The area around the natural springs was redeveloped several times during the Early and Late Middle Ages. (**Roman Baths Entrance not Included**)



Later proceed back to London. Drop at 1 designated place in London.
